To increase participant's knowledge and skills in responding effectively to survivors of Domestic, Sexual and Gender Based Violence (DSGBV) at an individual and organizational level:

Outcomes:

Participants will be able to recognize additional barriers for victims/survivors in particular situations including barriers related to culture and disability.

Participants will have increased understanding of societal influences on our assumptions and attitudes in relation to DSGBV.

Participants will have a greater insight into the mind of the abuser, how they operate and the dynamics of coercive control.

Participants will be able to identify manipulative tactics used in grooming victims, their family and friends as well as professionals and organizations.

Participants will develop the skills necessary to provide an appropriate first response to a survivor of DSGBV.

Participants will be able to implement effective inter-agency working practice in relation to DSGBV.
